PROGRAM/PRESENTATION – DANIEL KEHRER, Senior Civil Engineer, City of Citrus Heights

The city has done an extensive study of the roads, particularly the corridor gaps. They plan to start by completing their master plan for Old Auburn Road. The presentation was for the area between Garry Oak and the Holy Family Catholic Church. Mr. Kehrer brought a number of maps/diagrams to explain their proposal. It includes:

- *Making this section available to all modes of traffic and remove the conflict at the intersection at Fair Oaks and Old Auburn.
- *The bike trail along Old Auburn will be continued through this section with a raised buffer protection for cyclists.
- *Landscape strips and 6 foot sidewalks will be installed.
- *There will be no free right turns, but full stops.
- *The Glenn Tree curve will be lowered/straightened for better visibility.
- *It will provide better access to McDonald's Field baseball park.
- *There will be better access for crossing Sunrise installed.
- *Grant money should be in place to start construction in 2025 or 2026.

There were many, many questions and much discussion. It is a project we need to follow and give input to.
